The Sister City Symposium will be an exciting opportunity to bring government officials, academic scholars and business leaders from Taipei and Atlanta together and to promote collaboration between the people of both cities.

The event begins with The Sister City Symposium on August 2nd at Georgia Tech, followed next day by The CAPASUS Annual Conference on August 3rd with two sessions in the morning and two sessions in the afternoon separated by a luncheon at Atlanta Marriott Northeast/Emory Area.
